

**WEST EXTENSION IRRIGATION DISTRICT  
RESOLUTION NO. 21-008**

**LIMITING THE SIZE OF LAND TO BE SERVED BY THE DISTRICT TO  
1/3 OF AN ACRE**

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors (BOD) of the West Extension Irrigation District (WEID) is a federal irrigation district and was designed for agriculture use, and

WHEREAS, the BOD is concerned about its ability to effectively deliver water to small lots within the District, and

WHEREAS, Oregon Revised Statues allow for small lots to be excluded, and


WHEREAS, the BOD intends this action to be effective in the future, not on existing lands, and


WHEREAS, the BOD has decided that it is in the best interest of the WEID, now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the BOD of the WEID establishes 1/3 of an acre or more for land to be serviced in the future. The action taken under this resolution is to be added to the Land Development policies and water right transfer policies of the District, as shown on Page 2 of this Resolution.

FURTHER, BE IT RESOLVED that the effective date of this act is June 1, 2021.
