Job Description

Irrigation Systems Laborer (Temporary)

This position will report directly to the Field Supervisor or his designee. The work will be Monday through Friday from 7 am to 4:00 pm. Saturday work and overtime with short notice may be required, due to water start-up, weather events, urgent or emergency situations The duties of this position are performed in the field and involve monitoring, repair and maintenance of the District's irrigation system.

Knowledge:

- 1) Must have basic knowledge of an irrigation system such as valves, filters and unions.
- 2) Must know basic safety rules and work in a safe manner.

Abilities:

- 1) Must be able to work cooperatively with others and take direction.
- 2) Must be able to assist with repair of ditches, PVC pipe, concrete and other district distribution system components.
- 3) Must be able to assist with functions relative to delivering water within the irrigation district such as opening and closing manual headgates, turning pumps on or off.
- 4) Must be able to assist with general shop and grounds maintenance and clean-up.
- 5) Must be able to operate a variety of hand tools, as directed. Tools include shovels, weed eater, weed sprayer.
- 6) Must be able to work safely and effectively with others.
- 7) Must have a good driving record as use of a company vehicle may be needed.
